Our goal is to effect change both within and beyond our community, particularly in the face of ongoing assaults on LGBTQ+ rights.

We believe in the universal language of film, which helps people discover shared humanity. As we confront institutionalized bias, we are driven to educate through powerful stories captured on film.

Our vision encompasses inclusive representation of trans individuals, people of color, and all members of our diverse community. Through a curated selection of films, we aim to foster connection and relatability for audiences regardless of sexual orientation or gender identity.

## aGLIFF'S ANNUAL PRISM LGBTQ+ FILM FESTIVAL

aGLIFF's 36th Film Festival is the largest LGBTQ+ film festival in Texas. Presenting more than 50 feature films, documentaries, shorts and music videos, the fest celebrates the rich tapestry of LGBTQ+ stories.

We have a long-standing commitment to amplifying marginalized voices. Our Queer Black Voices Program annually recognizes the talent of emerging filmmakers via special screenings, monetary prizes, an awards dinner and mentorship by renowned black filmmakers.

We pay tribute to groundbreaking queer filmmakers by bringing them in for retrospective screenings. This honors their contribution and provides inspiration for emerging LGBTQ+ filmmakers.

Collaboration is at the heart of the festival. We work with over 40 community partner organizations whose missions align with the broader education of LGBTQ+ issues and representation. Through live Q&A sessions, panels, and community discussions, we foster meaningful dialogue and create a space for engaging with the thought-provoking content.

aGLIFF'S QUEER BLACK VOICES FUND To ensure that queer Black creatives are represented as part of the PRISM Film Fest every year, aGLIFF launched the Queer Black Voices Fund in 2020. Created in response to the events surrounding the deaths of George Floyd, Ahmaud Arbery, Breonna Taylor, and Javier Ambler, among other incidents between police officers and African Americans, the QBV Fund will cover the costs associated with submitting and showing qualified films as part of Prism and aGLIFF's year-round programming.

### aGLIFF'S LEGACY HONOREE

aGLIFF's Legacy Honoree Award is given annually to a queer filmmaker whose work has been important in providing a foundation for the evolution of LGBTQ+ cinema. The award was first given to Austin filmmaker Yen Tan in 2018 to highlight the festival's commitment to local LGBTQ+ filmmakers but has evolved to celebrate a wider range of queer indie film pioneers. Previous winners include Yen Tan, Rose Trouche, Jim Fall, and Madeleine Olnek.

> In 2023, aGLIFF will celebrate director Darren Stein as its Legacy Honoree. Stein's body of work is significant, exploring teen and young adult life through a queer lens in a funny, dark and heartfelt manner. He will attend the PRISM 36 LGBTQ+ Film Festival in Austin to screen three of his groundbreaking queer cult classics – *Sparkler* (1997), *Jawbreaker* (1999), and a special 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Screening of *GBF* (2013). The event promises to include a star-studded red carpet and after party.
